

3 Pass/fail rules that end your exam

- 1. 95% rule: The test ends as soon as the computer is 95% sure you clearly meet or do not meet the passing standard.
- 2. Maximum-length rule: The test ends after you have answered all 145 questions.
- **3. Run-out-of-time rule:** The test ends after you have hit the time limit of 5 hours.

3 NCLEX scoring rules

- 1. **0/1 scoring:** each correct response earns one point, while incorrect responses receive zero points.
- 2. +/- scoring: rewards correct responses with one point and deducts one point for each incorrect answer.
- **3. Rationale scoring:** assesses your ability to identify cause–effect relationships; you get one point for each pair of connected answer options.
