## 3 Pass/fail rules that end your exam

1. $95 \%$ rule: The test ends as soon as the computer is $95 \%$ sure you clearly meet or do not meet the passing standard.
2. Maximum-length rule: The test ends after you have answered all 145 questions.
3. Run-out-of-time rule: The test ends after you have hit the time limit of 5 hours.

## 3 NCLEX scoring rules

1. $0 / 1$ scoring: each correct response earns one point, while incorrect responses receive zero points.
2. +/- scoring: rewards correct responses with one point and deducts one point for each incorrect answer.
3. Rationale scoring: assesses your ability to identify cause-effect relationships; you get one point for each pair of connected answer options.
