


CRANIAL NERVES

Cranial nerves are named and numbered in Roman numerals according to their location, from the front to the back of the brain.

V	Trigeminal	Facial sensation, taste & jaw movements	Two	But
VI	Abducens	Abduction of eyes	A thletes	My
VII	Facial	Facial expression & taste	Felt	Brother
VIII	Vestibulocochlear	Sense of hearing & balance	Very	Says
