# INCENTIVE SPIROMETRY (NURSING)




### Pre-procedure

- · Perform hand hygiene
- Provide privacy
- Explain the procedure to the client
- Raise the bed to the appropriate level
- · Assist the client to the semi-Fowler's position
- Perform a respiratory assessment
- If the client has a surgical incision, teach them to splint the incision with a pillow

#### **Procedure**

- 1. Instruct the client to exhale normally
- 2. Have the client put the mouthpiece up to their mouth
- Instruct the client to take a long, slow, deep breath
- Have the client hold their breath for 5 seconds
- 5. Have the client remove the mouthpiece and exhale
- 6. Set the gauge on the incentive spirometer to show the goal volume of inspired air
- After the client is able to return demonstrate the procedure, provide instructions on performing it independently



## Post-procedure & documentation

- Reassess client's respiratory status
- Return the bed to the lowest position
- · Perform hand hygiene
- Document the procedure


#### Be sure to document:

- Maximum inspiration volume
- Number of times it was used

#### Notify the healthcare provider if:

- Client experiences any signs of respiratory distress
- Volume obtained differs significantly from previous measurements
- · If the client is unable to achieve the inspiratory goal
