SAFE TOPICAL MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION



Supplies



Topical medication



Gloves



Gauze



Sterile saline to clean site

Procedure

- Verify medication using Seven Rights of Administration and review order.
- 2. Expose application site and assess skin.
- If necessary, clean the site using soap and water.
- Perform hand hygiene, reapply gloves.
- 5. Open the topical medication.
- Apply medication to gloved hand or directly to site.
- Use smooth, gentle strokes to evenly apply medication to affected area.
- 8. Provide client with appropriate follow-up care instructions.
- Remove gloves, perform hand hygiene.



- Do not apply medication to skin that is not intact unless ordered to do so.
- Be aware that lotions and creams may interact with medications.
- If skin is dry or flakey, clean the area first and apply medication while skin is damp.
- Do not vigorously rub medication into skin.
- Remember that mucus membranes will absorb medications more rapidly than skin.
- Routinely assess the application site.
