







WHAT ARE REPORTABLE SAFETY EVENTS?



Serious Reportable Events (SRE) are preventable incidents involving death or serious harm to a client resulting from a lapse or error in a healthcare facility

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Impersonation of a physician, nurse, pharmacist, or other licensed provider • Abduction of a client • Sexual assault of a client • Death or injury of client or staff resulting from physical assault 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Procedure on wrong body part • Procedure on wrong client • Wrong procedure on client • Unintended object left in client • Intraoperative or post-procedure death of healthy client 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maternal death or disability in low-risk labor and delivery • Stage 3 or 4 pressure ulcer after admission <p>Death or disability associated with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medication error • Incompatible blood • Hypoglycemia • Hyperbilirubinemia in neonate • Spinal manipulative therapy 
Patient protection events	Product or device events	Environmental events
<p>Death or disability due to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Client elopement • Client suicide, attempted suicide, or self-harm • Discharge or release of client to an unauthorized person 	<p>Death or disability associated with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of contaminated drugs, devices, or biologics • Use of device other than as intended • Malfunctioning equipment: Sequester for testing and follow up, if needed. 	<p>Death or disability associated with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electrical shock • Wrong or contaminated oxygen or other gas • Burns • Falls • Restraints or bed rails
